Pledges: American Flag, Christian Flag, Bible, Classroom Rules

Bible: Old Testament & New Testament, Memory Verses, Catechism

Phonics: Letter sounds & recognition, vowels & consonants, word families, sight words, CVC & CVCC patterns, long vowel words, blends & digraphs

Handwriting: Pre-cursive alphabet, practicing lowercase and uppercase letter formations, first/last names, and basic sentence components, numbers

Reading: Small groups based on skill level. Each child has own set of full-color, engaging, themed readers. Typically one book per week.

Math: Manipulatives, building number sense, position, ordinal numbers, shapes, counting to 100 by 1's & 10's, early addition/subtraction, introductions in measurement, equal parts, money, time, calendar and dot patterns

Social Studies & Science: Various concepts are thematically tied into the phonics and reading curriculum
